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The Montessori Training Centre of BC will once again offer an Association Montessori Internationale (“AMI”) Assistants 3-6 Course. The intention of the course is to help interested adults become able assistants both at home as well as in a Montessori Children’s House (children 2½ to 6+ years old). It highlights the important work of the adult as an aid to the child’s development at the crucial early stages of life; knowledge and understanding that could be applied at home.

The course lectures will consist of study from the following areas:

This full-time course lasts two weeks from Monday, March 18 to 29, 2019.

Classes begin at 8:45 a.m. and end at 4:15 p.m. with an hour for lunch daily. Course work will consist of lectures, the reading of selected Montessori passages, discussion, practical aspects for implementation and the completing of an Assistant’s Album. An AMI Children’s House Assistants Course Certificate of Completion and transcript will be issued, based upon 90% attendance, course participation and the completion of the Assistant’s Album and material.

The non-refundable application fee is \$200.00, the tuition fee is \$950.00 and the material fee is \$40 payable in full when you register. Sufficient registration is required by March 8 to ensure the course is offered. All fees are refundable if the course is cancelled.
