Criminal Record Check Instructions: eCRC Service

Course Applicants:

As of July 28, 2021, the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General has implemented the new applicant based online service (eCRC) using the BC Services Card as Electronic Identity Verification (EIV). This new service will lead to a more user-friendly service for our students and will provide a more streamlined, secure, and accessible service for applicants.

The BC Services Card replaced the CareCard and provides access to health care services and other government services conveniently and securely under one card. The BC Services Card was designed to ensure personal information is kept secure using modern technology with advanced security feathers.

New eCRC service

- •Identity verification: In the new eCRC system, an applicant's identity is verified using their BC Services Card. If the applicant is using the BC Services Card to access the online service for first time, they will be directed to activate their card by video or in person through Service BC. Please note if applicants choose to activate their card in person, a mobile device is still required (iPhone, iPad, or Android).
- •Cost: There is no charge associated with activating a BC Services Card and the criminal record check fee is a fee of \$28.00.
