Course Objectives:

The Orientation Course is an introduction to the developmental characteristics and needs of children between 6 and 12 years of age. It provides valuable information for parents, caregivers, school staff or any individual seeking general knowledge about Montessori developmental theory and education.

This course highlights the important work of the adult as an aid to the elementary aged child's development.

The course supports the following objectives:

- To learn how to observe the elementary child
- To learn how to interact with the elementary aged child
- To gain knowledge of Montessori philosophy on education for children aged 6-12 years
- To understand the importance of prepared environment: indoor and outdoor
- To support social, moral and intellectual development of elementary children
- To explore how an adult can best support optimal development for this age group in any environment, and to identify and remove obstacles to optimal development.

Duration of the Course Programme:

- Sixty hours of course lectures and coursework completed synchronously and asynchronously online; nine additional hours of observation in a Montessori Elementary classroom.

Course Structure:

Online Synchronous Sessions: Thirty-three hours of seminars, discussions, lectures, observation exercises, and group activities held online from January 29, February 3, 5, 10, 17, 19, 24, 26 & March 2, 4 and 5 from 4:00 pm - 7:00 pm Pacific Time.

Asynchronous Sessions: Twenty-seven hours of videos, readings and assignments

Observation: 9 hours of observation arranged independently by the student in a Montessori Elementary Classroom.

Required Reading:

Selected reading from the following books will be assigned during the course:

- To Educate the Human Potential
- From Childhood to Adolescence
- The Formation of Man
- Education and Peace

All reading materials used in the course will be furnished through our learning management system. Books are available for sale (optional) from the MTCBC office.

Observation:

- 9 hours of observation parallel to the course. Observations to be completed either in a Montessori elementary classroom or in a playground or park where children are free to move around. Specific topics will be given for the observation assignments.

Requirements for Certification:

- Completion of course
- Submission of three papers (500 words each) on topics set by the course director and to be submitted by a date set by the course director.
- Submission of observation notes and assignment by a date set by the course director.
- A minimum of 90% of synchronous attendance is required for certification and 100% asynchronous & observation hours must be completed.
- All tasks must be completed for certification.

Admission Requirements:

- One must be 19 years of age at graduation and have Grade 12 OR have Mature Student Status (19 years of age or older)
- High School level English is required as translators are not permitted
- Completion of a course application & Student Enrolment Contract
- Photocopy of one Government ID with photo (driver's license, passport, birth certificate, etc.)
- A non-refundable application fee of \$250, tuition fee of \$1000, online learning management fees of \$50 (refundable if unable to attend and 10 business days' notice is given)

Certification Awarded:

- AMI Elementary Orientation Certificate (internationally recognized)
